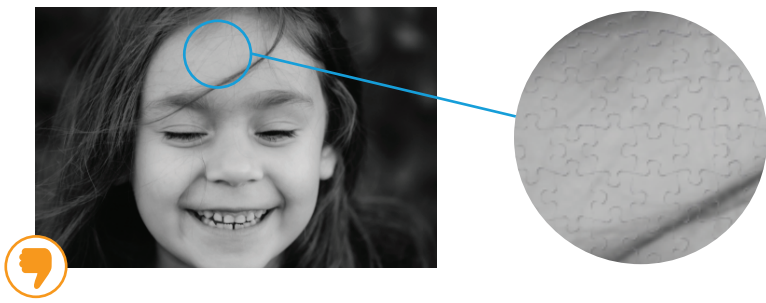
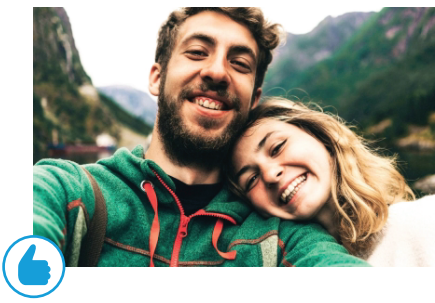


Personalised puzzles

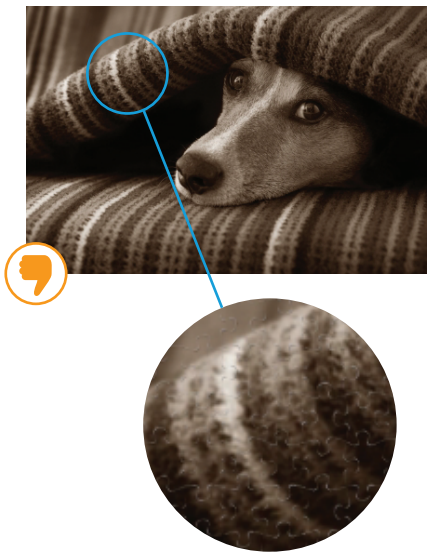
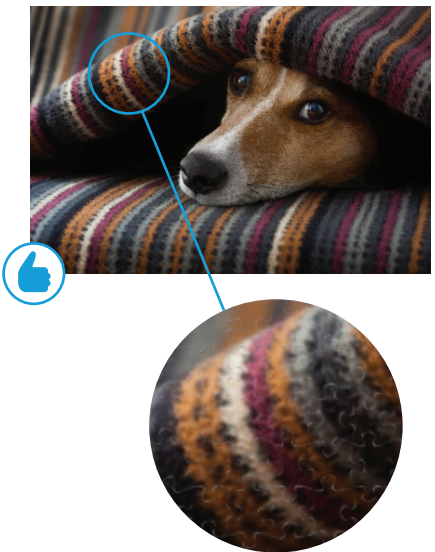
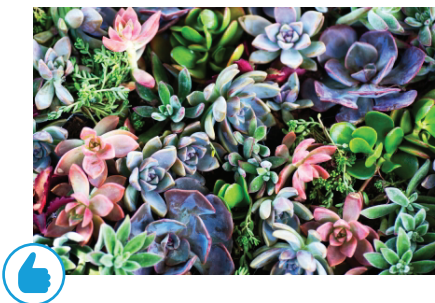
Information sheet

Below you can find a few tips on how to select the perfect photo for your puzzle. Of course you don't have to follow them if you're looking for a real challenge, but they can make your puzzling experience a bit easier and enjoyable.

- 1** Choose a photo with a lot of different **details**. This allows you to focus on different areas when creating the puzzle. Avoid a photo with too few details, such as monochrome backgrounds or a portrait of someone's face.



- 2** Choose a photo with lots of different **colours**. For example a photo of the ocean contains lots of detail but not enough different colours. Avoid using a photo with a lot of dark colours or sepia tones. Photos in black & white are also not recommended.



- i** You can **zoom in and out** on your image in the editor by clicking on the + & - symbols.
