# Happy families



## Game rules



### 3 or more players:

The object of the game is to collect as many families (groups of 4 cards that belong together) as possible. Deal out all the cards so that every player gets an equal number of cards. The dealer starts by asking another player for a card needed to complete a family. If the other player has the card he must give it to you.

You may continue asking for cards until you make a mistake. When a mistake is made the player who was asked for his card takes his turn to request cards. That player can retake the cards taken in the

previous round. When a player gathers a family he must put the 4 cards face down on the table in front of him. The player who collects the most sets is the winner.

### 2 players:

The dealer deals 10 cards to each player and places the undealt pack face down. Usually the other player starts by asking for a certain card. The player must already have one family card. If the other player does not have the card, the first player picks up the top card from the pack and it is then the second players turn to ask.
