Game rules



The object of the game is to win the most pairs (2 identical cards). The cards are shuffled and without being seen are laid face down on the table. A randomly chosen player starts; the others follow playing clockwise.

In turn, each player turns over two cards. If a player turns over two identical cards then they keep them and continue by turning over two more. If they turn over two different cards then they are replaced, face-down, and then it's the next player's turn. The game continues in this way until all the cards on the table have been taken. The player with the most pairs wins.
